

In Text Citations/Parenthetical Citations

Wilson Rawls describes the girl pup as being “small and timid” whereas the boy was “bold and aggressive” (33).

- Author’s name is in the sentence- don’t have to use it again in the citation.
- Words that are taken directly from the book are put in quotation marks.
- Page number is put in () parenthesis
- Period comes AFTER everything!

Both pups were very different the girl was “small and timid” and the boy was “bold and aggressive” (Rawls 33).

- Author’s name is NOT in the sentence- It MUST be in the citation.
- Words that are taken directly from the book are put in quotation marks.
- Author’s name and Page number is put in () parenthesis
- Period comes AFTER everything!

The boy and girl pups were very different. He was bold and would challenge anything or anyone. She was more shy and smaller than the boy (Rawls 33).
