

6th, 7th and 8th grade volleyball

Thank you for participating in our middle school volleyball program! We are so excited to have our middle school sports program back! Thank you for allowing your child to participate, as it is a lot of fun! [The CR Anderson Sports Program is to provide equal and safe opportunities for all students to participate. Team Placement: Due to the overwhelming number of volleyball players, we are going to run team placement a little differently this season. It is very important for all players to show up to their assigned team placement day and time. We will be using both gyms.

8th graders will have their team placement on Tuesday (3/15) from 3:00-4:00 PM

7th graders will have their team placement on Thursday (3/17) from 3:00-4:00 PM

6th graders will have their team placement on Friday (3/18) from 3:00-4:00 PM

Teams will be posted on Monday! The students will need to pay attention to their coach, practice time, and gym. These are final teams and we will not make any changes after this time. **Please make sure that your child knows the time, place, and coach!**

Practices: We start practices with teams starting on March 22nd. Your child may have practice at 3:00, 4:00 or 5:00 PM. All practices are Tuesday through Friday and will remain the same all season long. *We will not be taking any requests for teams or practice times.* Please be understanding and know that not everyone will have practice right after school. We will provide a study hall for any player who has a 4:00 PM practice time. They can stay at CR and go to a classroom to work on homework. Students are not allowed to stay in the gym to watch other practices or be in the halls.

Games: All games will be played at either HMS, CRA, and Central School.

The game times will be run on a 35 minute clock and we will try to get as much volleyball in during that time as we can. The game schedule will be released after team placements are decided. Games will start after spring break. Your child will receive a schedule before spring break. We will also post the schedule on the CRA website.

It is the responsibility of your child to get to their assigned gym time for the game. The school and coaches will not provide transportation to HMS or Central. There will not be practices on the nights of games.

There is no supervision for students during volleyball games. If your child wants to stay and watch, they need to be in a gym and being respectful.
